Progress has been positive throughout multiple areas of the project during September. Externally, we have now removed 90% of the façade retention system and progressed the mansard roof systems on both Sackville Street and Piccadilly. Behind the monarflexed scaffold, stonework continues to be erected.

Internally, our focus continues to be the coordination of fit out works and progressing through the floors in sequence. In the last period, we were pleased to see the raised access flooring, plastering and joinery commence on multiple floors.

- Perimeter scaffold continued.
- Concrete works completed.
- Façade works and window installation continued on the Sackville St. and Albany elevations.
- Feature staircase first-fix bracketry continued.
- Mansard roof steel works continued.
- Rooftop plant installation continued.
- Brick and blockwork continued.
- Fitout works progressed including screeding, MEP, drylining, tiling, plastering, joinery and decorating.
- Riser door installation continued.
- Firestopping works continued.

12 Week Look Ahead

- Removal of the façade retention system will continue.
- Perimeter scaffold adaptaptions to faciliate window install will continue.
- Façade works and window installation will progress to all levels.
- Mansard roof steelwork to complete.
- Feature staircase first-fix bracketry to complete and glass panels installed.
- Brick and blockwork will continue throughout all floors.
- Fitout works including MEP, drylining, plastering, tiling, joinery and decorating will continue.
- Riser door installation will continue.
- Firestopping works to continue.
