Site Boundary

- Turnstile and new hoarding installed.
- Façade access scaffold including staircase and monarflex complete.
- Façade consultant initial inspection conducted.
- Façade retention scheme maintenance continued.

Pegasus House

- Removal of existing foundations and obstructions.
- Pegasus House piling complete and pile cap formations commenced.
- L-block loading bay at gate 4 was completed.
- King post propping to Sackville Street elevation complete.
- B2 capping beam complete and temporary propping installed.
- Tower crane erected 3rd and 4th August.
- Thrust block removal works continued.
- B2 bulk excavation commenced.
- Vent tunnel works commenced.
- Trimming of Albany Court wall protrusions continued.

Nuffield House

- Nuffield House pile cap formations and removal of existing foundations completed.
- Nuffield House basement slab pours complete.
- Manhole and drainage construction continued.

- Substructure works continue.
 - Pegasus House pile cap formations will continue.
 - Pegasus House slab pours will continue.
 - Liner wall works.
- Temporary work installations continue.
 - Excavating / reducing level in Pegasus House.
 - Thrust block removal along Sackville Street elevation.
 - Albany Court render removal from party wall.
 - Trench sheet installations to facilitate drainage and ventilation works.
 - Slipform assembly for core erection.


Works visible / audible at perimeter of site



- Trimming down tops of piles for pile cap formation..
 - Continue to use best practical methods.
 - Where breaking is required, noisy works will continue to follow the 2 hours on / 2hours off approach in line with our Section 61 as well as the protocols set out in the Neighbourly Agreements.
- Trench sheet installations as part of temporary works to facilitate drainage and ventilation works
- Trimming of Albany Court wall
 - Works have continued this week and no further exceedances have been received on the Albany Court noise monitor.
 - We are currently in the process of exposing the remaining section of wall to conduct a survey and understand if any further works are required.

Initiatives



- McLaren have introduced Alex Talks our Community Liaison Coordinator. Alex will be taking the lead on all community matters, answering all queries relating to the project and ensuring all members of the community are communicated to with updates and relevant information in a timely manner.
- Inspections of the site boundary will be completed daily. Any observations and required actions will be recorded. Alex will also respond to any observations reported by 3rd parties.
- Newsletters and CLG meetings will continue.
- McLaren will be issuing notification to local residents of Saturday works in advance of them taking place with a four week look ahead issued at the same time.
- The works have been sequenced to complete the blockwork on Sackville St. and Albany Court as early as possible to create an additional acoustic and dust barrier.
- Over the coming weeks and months McLaren will constantly review the operations and look at new initiatives to support the community, we will continue to use this meeting as an opportunity to share them.

Observations and Feedback



We have received two compliments and two complaints in the period.

- Two complaints were received during phase one of the trench sheet installation adjacent to Albany Court party wall for the vent tunnels.
- On both occasions work paused whilst an investigation took place and Sandy Brown acousticians were
 consulted. During both periods of installations, no vibration exceedances were recorded on the Section 61 or
 Neighbourly Agreement monitors.
- On the 20th August, during a site-based neighbourly meeting, we were complemented on the management of the project.
- The second compliment was received from an external auditor for the project who complimented the project team on hospitality and coordination.
