Envelope

Albany Elevation

- Blockwork complete on all levels.
- Brickwork progressing; L4 to L5.
- Aluminium windows completed to Nuffield elevation.
- Feature staircase 1st fix bracketry and mullion install commenced.
- Stair A roof steelwork erected.

Sackville St. Elevation

- Blockwork complete on all levels.
- Stone facade continues Ground to L1, bays 4-7. (Bay 2&3 complete).
- Sackville mansard steelwork & dormer frames inc, insulation & plywood complete.

Piccadilly Elevation

- FRS on retained façade struck to gantry level and scaffold being rebuilt @ 2.0m lifts.
- Timber removal from windows complete on levels 2 to 6.

Roof works

- Blue roof and pebbles progressed.
- AHU installed and ductwork progressed.
- Piccadilly mansard fire boarding to steelwork progressed.
- Residential SFS commenced.

Fit-out

- MEP install continues B2 to L5.
- IPS units continued on levels 1 4.
- Floor tiling to L1-5 washrooms complete.
- Screeding complete, B1 to L5.
- UKPN switch over over complete and the Sackville Street Temporary sub-station removed.
- Internal blockwork continued.
- Drylining progressing on levels 1-6.
- Raised Access Flooring progressed to L1 and L2.
- Plastering to columns and walls L1 to L3.
- Plastering to L1 ceiling commenced.
- CAM units delivered for L1&L2; (installed on L1).

Temporary Works / Site Logistics

- Perimeter Access Scaffold.
 - Sackville Street complete.
 - Piccadilly elevation being re-erected.



Envelope

- Roof works
 - SFS and plywood will be completed to the resi mansard.
 - Waterproofing to level 9 slab will be carried out.
- Albany Elevation
 - Brickwork walls (external), including supporting steelwork will continue throughout all floors.
 - Curtain walling framework will continue to Stair A.
- Sackville St. Elevation.
 - Tyvek and battens to be installed on the Sackville mansard.
 - Brickwork L5-roof & for mansard finishes.
 - Scaffolding for mansard, including upper niko rail.
 - Stonework completion to allow brickwork at level 2 to commence.
 - Brickwork continuing on Bay 2 and Bay 3.
 - Stone completed to Bay 3 to Bay 7.

Fit-out

- Screeding will complete to level 6.
- MEP (Mechanical Electrical & Public Health) installation will continue across all floors.
- Drylining to continue throughout all floors.
- Washroom installation to continue.
- Washroom floor tiling will complete, wall tiling to continue.
- Firestopping to continue.

Temporary Works / Site Logistics

• Re-route site entrance, security hut and turnstiles.

Initiatives

- McLaren have introduced Alex Talks our Community Liaison Coordinator. Alex will be taking the lead on all community matters, answering all queries relating to the project and ensuring all members of the community are communicated to with updates and relevant information in a timely manner.
- Inspections of the site boundary will be completed daily. Any observations and required actions will be recorded. Alex will also respond to any observations reported by 3rd parties.
- Newsletters and CLG meetings will continue.
- McLaren will be issuing notification to local residents of Saturday works in advance of them taking place with a four week look ahead issued at the same time.
- The works have been sequenced to complete the blockwork on Sackville St. and Albany Court as early as possible to create an additional acoustic and dust barrier.
- Over the coming weeks and months McLaren will constantly review the operations and look at new initiatives to support the community, we will continue to use this meeting as an opportunity to share them.


